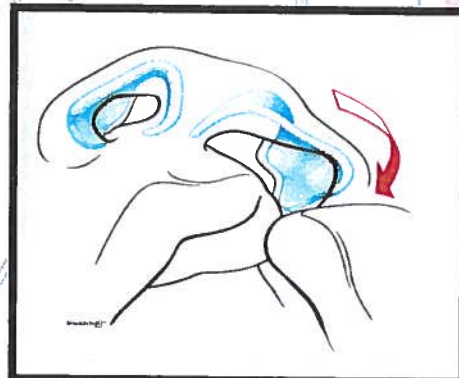

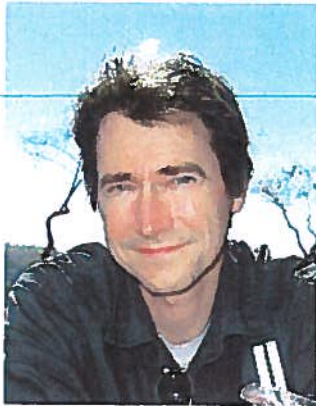

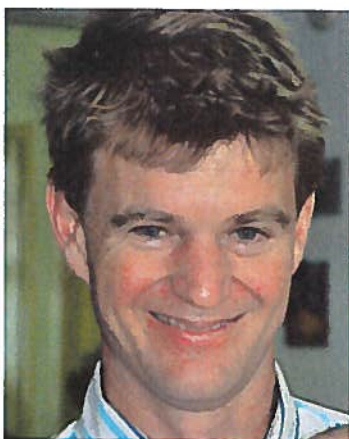

Ronald Bleys:



Ronald Bleys is an allround anatomist with an enormous teaching experience, including training of medical residents and specialists. Under his direction the department of Anatomy of UMC Utrecht has become a centre of excellence for postgraduate anatomical training in the Netherlands and hosts well known-international courses. His own specialty is the head and neck region. As for research his expertise is especially on blood vessels and the autonomic nervous system, as shown in his work on the innervation of cerebral arteries. Furthermore he has been participating in clinical anatomical research projects, often collaborations with clinicians of surgical disciplines.

Corstiaan Breugem



Corstiaan Breugem is a pediatric plastic surgeon working in the Wilhelmina Children's Hospital in Utrecht and Meander Medical Center, Amersfoort. After finishing his specialization in Amsterdam (including a PhD in vascular anomalies), he trained in Vancouver, Canada in 2005/2006 doing pediatric plastic surgery. His fields of interest include cleft

lip/palate, microtia and vascular anomalies. He also operates in countries where cleft lip and palate services are less well-developed.

Per Hal



Per has been a consultant for 15 years and works at the University teaching Hospital in Cambridge UK as a paediatric Plastic Surgeon. He is in charge of the Cleft Lip and Palate service for Eastern England treating around 80 new babies per annum. Per runs a course "Sculpture for Surgeons" which teaches, via the medium of clay, a 3 dimensional approach useful when performing facial reconstruction. He also is a volunteer surgeon for Operation Smile and is passionate about teaching and training in both his work in the UK and abroad.

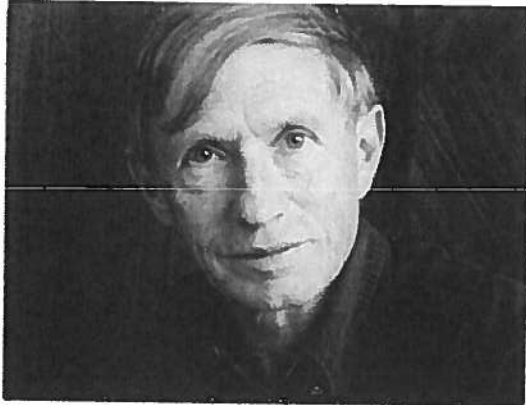
Aebele Mink van der Molen



Working as plastic surgeon at Wilhelmina Children's Hospital, Utrecht and as hand surgeon at St Antonius Hospital, Nieuwegein. As a plastic surgeon I (he) likes the multidisciplinary approach of the cleft team and seeing the children grow up. If there is time left after work and family, then archeology and history are always interesting subjects. His plastic surgery

interest include Cleft lip and palate , 22q11.2 DS (speech problems) and congenital hand- and upper extremity.

Brian Sommerlad



Brian Sommerlad is an honorary consultant plastic surgeon at Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children, London, and at the St Andrew's Centre for Plastic Surgery, Broomfield Hospital, Chelmsford. He was the first Clinical Director of the North Thames Cleft Lip and Palate Service (GOSTA). Although involved in many aspects of plastic surgery, his main activity now is centred around surgery for children and adults with cleft of lip and palate and associated conditions.

He has been particularly involved in the development of the operating microscope for cleft palate repair and in refining surgery for repair of the muscles in cleft palate, and in re-repairing the cleft palate as an alternative to pharyngoplasty in some patients. He regularly visits countries where cleft lip and palate services are less well-developed, to work with local surgeons and to assist in their development of multi-disciplinary teams. He is a member of the Medical Advisory Board of **Smile Train**, a US based charity dedicated to empowering and supporting local surgeons and teams to carry out cleft lip and palate surgery. He is a past president of both the British Association of Plastic Surgeons and the Craniofacial Society of Great Britain and Ireland.
